A MESSAGE FROM THE FINANCE COUNCIL

We finished the year ended June 30, 2020 with an operating cash flow surplus of \$420,810, an \$800,636 improvement when compared to a \$379,825 cash flow deficit for the year ended June 30, 2019. This contributed to an increase in our operating cash position to \$1.58 million at June 30, 2020 compared to \$841,785 at June 30, 2019. This is our first annual operating cash flow surplus since 2016, when we started full principal and interest payments on our debt.

We are truly grateful to all parishioners and especially the school families who helped make this possible. We are now in a very strong position to support our ongoing Parish Missions and Operations.

We made the difficult transition to a tuition-based model for funding the school during this fiscal year, which significantly contributed to the improved cash position. The school tuition receipts are included in Total Other Receipts in the above financial statements, which increased \$1.0 million for the year ended 2020 compared to 2019.

We, as a Parish, responded in a very supportive manner with the request to help balance the operating budget for this upcoming fiscal year. An additional \$229,449 was committed in support. 325 families participated with an average gift of \$706. We are very blessed as Parishioners of Saint James Parish and appreciate everyone who was able to give monetarily and through your prayers.

We also refinanced our debt during the year, which was \$6.5 million at June 30, 2020. This helped reduce debt service during the 2020 fiscal year and will continue to reduce annual payments by approximately \$97,000 per year.

Operating expenses declined 19%, or \$94,588 for the year ended June 30, 2020 compared to the year ended June 30, 2019 through constant efforts to manage two campuses efficiently.

STRATEGIC PLANNING

The Saint James Parish Pastoral Council embarked upon a strategic plan for the parish. In the fall of the year, plans were underway to identify significant pillars on which to survey the parish. In early 2020, a parish survey was submitted to gain parishioner feedback.

The survey addressed the following pillars: Communication, Evangelization, Fellowship, Formation, Operational Vitality, Stewardship as a Way of Life, Worship.
