

The St. Vincent de Paul Outreach (Food Pantry) ended its fiscal year September 30, 2024. We would like to thank all our parishioners for their generous monetary and food donations. Thank you for "helping us, help others!" Here's what your donations meant to the needy in our community in terms of dollars and people assisted over this past fiscal year.

Food: \$88,699.00 (estimated retail value of food distributed); 1,784 households assisted with 3,310 individuals therein.

Utilities: \$35,986.00; 370 households assisted with 801 individuals residing therein.

Housing (Rent and Motel): \$6,126.00; 82 clients assisted with 173 family members.

Other: (bus tickets, gasoline, prescriptions, etc.): \$7,062.51; 660 clients assisted with 1,334 family members.

TOTAL: \$137,873.97 expended to help 2,896 house-holds/individuals with 5,618 family members residing with these households.
